



DIVISIONS

- Youth.** Under 18 years of age (or still in High School)
- Young Adult.** 18 years to 35 years of age (no longer in HS)
- Adult.** 35 to 60 years of age
- Senior.** 60+ years of age
- Group.** Any group of youth, teens, adults

CATEGORIES

- Community Service.** Volunteer work that meets a need in the community through action, education, or service.
- Diversity.** Volunteer work that values cultural and/or social diversity by promoting awareness and education.
- Leadership.** Volunteer work that demonstrates the ability to lead others toward a positive goal.
- Community Advocacy.** Volunteer work by that demonstrates civic responsibility or action for the good of the community.
- Asset Building.** Volunteer work that betters the lives of youth in our community through asset building.

NOMINATION CRITERIA

Emphasis is given to nominees whose significant contributions have been made in the last 18 months. The contribution of the individual or group must be within Latah County. Any community member (adult or youth) may nominate any youth, young adult, adult, senior, or group. A nomination form must be completed for each nominee. A one-page letter that specifically describes the impact of the nominee's actions much be included.
